



CALLING ALL PHOTOGRAPHERS!



Here are further details of the photography event being mounted by the Friends of St Mary's at St Mary's Church, Halesworth, during the Heritage Open Days,
September 17th and 18th, 2022.

There will be three **classes**: young people (18 or younger on September 16th); adults; Camera Club members. Prizes will be awarded in each class.

The **theme** is "Local Life in 2022" – any aspect(s) of your choice.

Entries: You may enter up to five photos of any size. They can be landscape or portrait; b/w or colour; matt or gloss. Please **mount** each photo yourself with a mount of suitable width and colour, and on the back of the photo, in soft pencil, write your name, when the picture was taken and where (if significant), and your chosen title/caption. Captions in uniform script will be added to the front by us after submission. Pictures will be attached to display boards by self-adhesive Velcro applied to the back of the mount, not to the photo itself.

Dates: Entries may be brought to the church from Saturday 27th August until Saturday 10th September as follows: Saturdays 10am - 12noon; Sundays 11am - 12noon; Wednesdays 11am - 12noon. A steward will be there at these times to receive them and to ask you to fill in an entry form giving titles/captions and your contact details.

Judging will take place during the evening of Friday 16th September and the photos will be on display from Saturday 17th until Wednesday 21st September.

Prizes will be given out after the afternoon recital on Sunday 18th September, about 4.15 pm.

Photos can be **collected** from the afternoon of the 21st. Please note that they may be left in an unmanned church at the owners' risk, so you may prefer to take them after the prizegiving on Sunday 18th.

We do hope that many of you, no matter how experienced or whatever your photographic equipment, will enjoy planning (or not!) and taking your entries for this exhibition and competition. Let's put on a really fine show!
