

WALKING THE

BLYTH VALLEY CHURCHES

Route Halesworth to Chediston

Parking in the Pay and Display Council Angel Link Car Park within sight of The Angel pub [///round.tacky.nature](http://round.tacky.nature)

Walk up to and past The Angel turning left towards the War Memorial entrance to St Mary Church. On leaving the church pass through the alley to the Market Place keeping left passing the Rosedales office and turning left onto Chediston Street.

Look out for, and turn down, Rectory Lane on the right dropping between the houses past a crinkle-crankle wall, along the Blyth, past The Old Rectory and up to Rectory Street. Turn left and left again onto the private unsurfaced School Lane passing the nursery. Cross the bridge and go through the kissing-gate onto the pasture. Keep straight ahead.

Go through the kissing-gate and continue ahead onto the farm track with open fields on either side. Turn right at Chediston Hall farm access track and left through the yard after passing the pond looking out for Swallows in the summer. Head out on the track across more cropped fields. With views of a house to your left, it drops down and rises as a path up and across another field entering Herne Hill Farm across a modest bridge and a kissing-gate. Cross the field and go through a kissing-gate. Go through the next into another field. Go through the next two to cross the surfaced farm access track. Dropping down to another, where, turn left and go through the hedge to pick up a fenced path across two more fields towards a thatched cottage.



Cross the sleeper bridge to the lane and go up the rough track straight ahead to visit St Marys Church which will hove into view on your right. On leaving walk round the church to the larger part of the churchyard heading across it towards the lane. Turn right and then left up Wissett Road. Continue past Rose Cottage, the fishing lakes and Paradise Farm, before turning right at the field entrance gap in the hedge and trees. Keep right.

Look out for deers as you approach and pass the solar farm through a gap in the hedge then crossing a bridge join a track again keeping to the right hand field boundary. Passing the pig unit, the route runs along the edge of Chediston Wood then a hedge-line. Turn left at the path junction and then right to stay within the field, briefly meeting Mill Road before turning right onto a track with a ditch to the right and trees to the left. Keep straight ahead into a tree-lined path that drops down to a bridge and up to Chediston Street.

Turn right then left up Beech Close following the road round to the left. Just before the garages turn left onto a surfaced path leading past an abandoned vegetable garden. Turn left as the path meets an access road next to the Roman Catholic Church. Continue straight ahead onto Steeple End with St Marys on your left. Turn left following the road round Bank House and past The Angel to return to you car.
